

Now Accepting Nominations for the 2017 Rachel Davis Award



The Rachel Davis Award was established by the Chapter several years ago to keep alive the memory of our 1996 KCHMM President, environmental colleague, and friend Rachel Davis by honoring her legacy. This award will be presented at the Chapter's annual meeting on January 10, 2018. The official nomination form is posted on the Chapter website, but you can also submit your Award nomination(s) by simply following these protocols:

- ▶ Candidates shall be nominated by a fellow KCHMM member (no self-nominations)
- ▶ Nominees must be credentialed Chapter members in good standing as of November 2017.
- ▶ Nominees shall have publicly demonstrated commitment to the Chapter and its mission.
- ▶ Preferred candidates will show civic involvement / leadership in environmental, safety, and humanitarian causes.

Nominations should consist of:

- Date of nomination
- Person submitting the nomination
- Person being nominated
- Briefly describe how you believe this candidate has demonstrated commitment to the Chapter and its mission (no more than 250 words)
- Briefly describe how you believe this candidate has demonstrated civic involvement and leadership in environmental, safety and humanitarian causes (no more than 500 words)

The review committee made up of the last three active recipients (Hussung, Sutter, and Greenberg) will evaluate all nominations received and will select this year's honoree. The recipient of the 2017 award will be announced at the Chapter's annual meeting on January 10, 2018.

The recipient will receive an award of one year of waived Chapter membership dues, recognition at the annual meeting, and a free dinner that evening.
